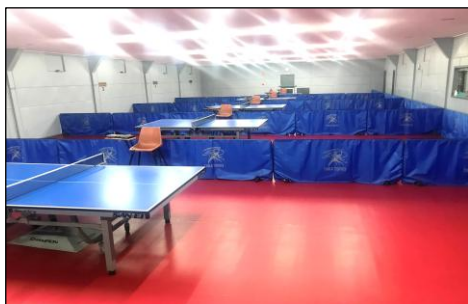

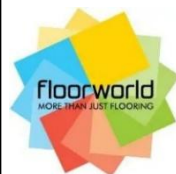

*Players may only enter 1 EVENT per TIME SLOT (and 1 rating event occurring at the same time i.e. a player cannot enter both an >1100 and >1500 event). Any player over 19 years of age can enter the O19 singles. Junior players may enter up to 3 age single events. Veteran players can enter up to 2 age singles events. 2 players advance from age singles & open singles. 1 player advances from rated singles. KO for all doubles.*



## 2025 TOOWOOMBA FLOORWORLD OPEN - TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(LODGEMENT OF AN ENTRY WILL BE CONSIDERED ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONDITIONS)

1. Players participate at their own risk. No claim for injury will be recognised.
2. Except as is herein provided, the tournament will be held under TTA and ITTF rules and regulations.
3. All players must be CLUB LEVEL registered members of clubs or associations affiliated with TTQ, TTA or international associations affiliated with ITTF.
4. All entry fees must be paid, (CASH /EFTPOS) immediately on arrival at the centre & before playing any event.
5. All players are expected to be available to umpire matches throughout that day.
6. Players may enter any event for which they are eligible, although players from lower grades may be balloted out of higher grades that have large entry numbers.
7. **No player is to enter two events with the same start time.**
8. **No player is to enter more than six (6) events on each day (doubles & singles counted as separate events).**
9. Unless specified otherwise, either a same sex team or a mixed sex team may enter doubles events.
10. Doubles players must ensure that their partner has submitted a separate entry form. If a partner is required, show "REQUIRED" in the space provided. All reasonable efforts will be made to pair unpartnered doubles players.
11. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
12. All seeding, grading and acceptance of entries is at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.  
Rated events: Are open to players whose rating is less than the points stated for the particular grade according to the most recent published list of Universal Ratings (Ratings Central - ratingscentral.com) as at the closing time of tournament entries. For doubles events, player eligibility is the individual rating of each player.  
Age events:
  - a. Veteran events: 19, 30, 40, 50, 60, 65, 70, 75 and 80 years of age as at 31 December 2025.
  - b. Junior events: Under 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21 years of age at 1 January 2025.
13. Where entry numbers and the timetable permit, the Tournament Committee will endeavour to provide each player at least two matches in each singles event by incorporating a Round Robin system. KO for all doubles.
14. If insufficient entries are received for any event, or for any other reason, events may be cancelled or combined with another event without prior notification.
15. Starting times are approximate. All players are requested to report to the control table on arrival, at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the event. If leaving the venue please advise the Referee.
16. Players not available to play when called upon will be liable to disqualification.
17. ITTF 3-star approved white balls will be used. Tables are blue SAN-EI Absolute W, with SAN-EI Limitless net assemblies. The primary colour of shirts, shorts and skirts shall be clearly different in colour to the ball. Hall flooring is red Taraflex on all six courts, with bright LED lighting provided.
18. Events 1 and 2 will be the best of 7 games in the semi-finals and finals. All other matches are best of 5 games.
19. The decision of the Referee will be final on a point of law. An umpire, whose decision will be final on a point of fact, shall control each match.
20. Bad language, offensive or unsportsmanlike behaviour or wilful damage will not be tolerated; with offenders liable to disqualification; the cost of necessary repairs.
21. Dress regulations will be enforced, including non-marking shoes. During play, caps or other head wear; accessories and tracksuits may only be worn with the permission of the Referee.
22. It is the responsibility of each player to ensure that racket coverings are attached to their racket blade with ITTF approved adhesives. Neither gluing nor re-gluing of rackets is permitted inside the playing hall. Only ITTF approved glues may be used.
23. In all events, prize money will be paid if four or more players/pairs participate. For all **Rated Events**, prize money is 40% (\$60 cap) for winner and 20% (\$30 cap) for runner up of event entry fees received.
24. **For Events 1 & 2, prize money is: \$400 winner, \$150 runner-up, \$75 losing semi-finalists. For Events 3, 4 & 5, prize money is \$120 winners (pairing), \$60 runners-up pair, \$30 losing semi-finalist pairs.**
25. **For ALL Junior & Veterans SINGLES events (events 14 - 24 & 26 - 38) prize money is \$75 winner, \$30 Runners-up.**
26. Time outs will be permitted.
